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The main activities of the Erasmus+ KA121 project "**Mreža prilika 2024**" were short-term mobilities of students and job shadowing activities for teachers of the Vocational school Đurđevac.



The goal of student mobilities was to carry out professional practice in companies and partner schools in Spain, Czechia, Poland and Slovakia, which was aimed at raising the professional competences of students for their competitiveness on the labor market, which is changing rapidly and requires specific knowledge and skills to perform certain jobs.

The goal of teacher mobilities was to familiarize with good practice examples in teaching work in partner schools in Spain and Czechia, to improve teaching skills and to acquire new knowledge in professional areas.



In addition to the above, students and teachers improved their communication, organizational and language skills and got to know the culture and history of the regions and countries they visited during mobilities.

pedicurist - nail art, nail polish techniques, soap making, bath salts and lip scrubs, wellness pedicures, nail and foot skin treatments and foot care

I learned pinda massage, which is not performed in the salon where I usually go for practice, as well as Spanish pedicure, which is different in some details than in our salons.“
